Special Notice of Open Board Position

Spreckels Veterans Memorial District is seeking applications for one open position on the Board of Directors, which meets the 1st Wednesday of each month. The District manages Spreckels Veterans Memorial Building and Spreckels Memorial Park.

Oversight for the District is by an elected Board of Directors, of which there are five members. Applicant's primary physical residence must be within District boundaries. [See map]

According to the California Military and Veteran's Code, 3 positions on Memorial District Boards must be reserved for military veterans. Applicants who are military veterans must be given first priority in filling this position. All candidates, whether veterans or not, are still encouraged to apply. If a veteran does not apply, a non-veteran may be appointed to the position.

Interested parties should request an *Application for Appointment to Fill Board Vacancy.* The application includes a summary of how this district operates and what the expectations of the appointed board member would be.
